Britain has elected "the most godless parliament in its history", with 40 per cent of MPs, including Prime Minister Sir Keir Starmer, choosing to 'affirm' their allegiance to the King rather than swear on the Bible.

Half the new cabinet also declined to express any religious belief on being sworn into the Commons after July's general election radically changed the make-up of parliament.

The increase in secular MPs is up

from 24 per cent at the start of the last parliament in 2019. The Times said, "Britain elected the

first parliament as godless as the nation at large." The big jump in irreligious MPs was the

result of the Labour landslide in which Starmer's party won 412 seats. Almost half of Labour MPs — 47 per cent affirmed, compared with only 9 per cent of Conservatives. The Liberal Democrats, who won a record 72 seats, also had 47 per cent of their MPs make an affirmation.

Christian campaigning organisations have expressed their worries about the new Labour government's agenda, which is also being seen as a reflection of a godless society.

With its so-called 'supermajority' of 181, Sir Keir Starmer's government has almost free rein to implement its radical manifesto.

Many MPs with a strong pro-life voting record have lost their seats and CitizenGo expects Labour to promote abortion and euthanasia.

Marriage

Traditional marriage is in danger of further denigration, according to Coalition for Marriage. Its director, Dr Tony Rucinski, told supporters in July

that although Sir Keir Starmer had only been in office for two weeks, "the evident shift in support for LGBT ideology among senior Government figures is already sparking concern from real marriage supporters and more widely."

There are fears that Labour's draft legislation to ban 'conversion therapy' could criminalise prayer or even conversations about unwanted same-sex attraction, because such conversations and prayer are confused with drastic and abusive practices, which are already illegal.

"THE MOST GODLESS PARLIAMENT EVER"

A group of church leaders representing more than 1,300 churches has written to the Prime Minister, warning that new laws could criminalise them as they put into practice their teaching on marriage.

Co-signatory of the letter Rev Dr Matthew Roberts told Premier the plans don't account for or understand Christian teaching. He said proposals for the bill include "anyone who wanted to negate or suppress people's sexual orientation or gender identity".

Roberts said: "A Christian sermon that calls people to repent of their sin and to live in a godly way is also about negating and suppressing our sins." The letter reads: "Campaigners often

imply that expressing mainstream, traditional Christian beliefs sexuality or gender identity in pastoral conversations is, inherently, a form of

'conversion therapy'." The letter also offers to help the Government understand traditional Christian teaching on marriage and distinguish it from abusive behaviours. Campaigners are hopeful that the Government may be open to listening.

Earlier in the year, then-Shadow

"Godless" parliament

The Greens are the most irreligious party, with all of their four MPs affirming rather than swearing on the Bible, as did six of the SNP's nine MPs. Tim Farron of the LibDems also affirmed rather than swore on a Bible. He told Premier his decision was based on Matthew 5:34-37, where Jesus says: "But I tell you, do not swear at all: either by heaven, for it is God's throne; or by the earth, for it is his footstool;... And do not swear by your head, for you cannot make even one hair white or black. Simply, let your 'Yes' be 'Yes' and your 'No' be 'No'; anything beyond this comes from the evil one.

Only one of Nigel Farage's five Reform MPs affirmed.

However, the majority of MPs, 338, swore on the Bible, usually the King James version.

There were 14 Muslim MPs, who swore on the Quran, and Rishi Sunak was one of three MPs to swear on the Bhagavad Gita, the Hindu holy book.

Equalities Minister Anneliese Dodds stated that "any ban must not cover legitimate psychological support and treatment". She also said any new legislation in this area must not criminalise "non-directive" pastoral "religious relationships between leaders and their worshippers" or "discussions within families". Rucinski said, "Life-long marriage between a man and a woman is the

foundation of a flourishing society. It must not become a crime to defend it.'

Babies' safety

Campaigners are concerned that pro-abortion Labour MPs Dame Diana Ĵohnson and Stella Creasy, who have been re-elected, will double down on their efforts to decriminalise abortion which would allow abortions to take place for any reason, right up to birth.

Right to Life UK also worries that the Human Fertilisation and Embryology Authority (HFEA) and biotech firms will push for more freedom to experiment on human embryos.

State-sponsored suicide

The new Prime Minister has not only voted in favour of assisted suicide in the past, but, along with all the major parties, has promised to hold a parliamentary vote on introducing assisted suicide.

Trump shot was prophesied

In the aftermath of the attempt on former President Trump's life in July, much publicity in Christian circles was given to a prophetic warning issued in March.

Pastor Brandon Biggs had foreseen a bullet striking Trump's ear, and, more precisely, perforating his ear drum. It is not known if that injury occurred.

Biggs also foresaw that the narrow escape would cause Trump, who calls himself a Christian and has often been photographed with pastors praying for him in the Oval Office, to fully surrender his life to God.

A few days after the attack, it was, in the words of The Spectator, a "curiously sombre" Trump who told the Republican convention, "I'm not supposed to be here tonight. I stand before you in this arena only by the grace of Almighty God".

Supporters are seeing Trump's escape as a miracle, especially after whistleblowers revealed that most of his security detail for the Pennsylvania

Meanwhile, Trump's pick for Vice-President, J D Vance, is a Catholic convert who grew up in an evangelical home and married a Hindu. Both men have expressed strong support for Israel.

GLASTO SINGS TO JESUS!

<u>We are commanded to pray for those in authority over us, in order that we may live</u> peaceable lives, but we now have a radical government, voted in by just one-third of us, that is promising to "change" our nation. Former Brighton councillor Christina <u>Summers analyses the key issues of concern to Bible believers</u>

here are three things about our fledgling Government of which we can be certain. Firstly, Labour or not, it is now ideologically the same as any other party (arguably save Reform). Party labels are almost meaningless now, so listen to Jesus instead, who insists "you will know them by their fruit" (Matthew 7:16).

Secondly, the UK electorate did not choose them – far from it. Starmer's party won the smallest popular vote share of any majority government in UK history – 33.7 per cent – yet gained 63 per cent of seats in the Commons. This gap between vote share and seats gained is the most disproportionate on record.

Thirdly, a revealing study by Politico highlights 27 (and counting) key U-turns in Starmer's spell as opposition leader, so we should not expect Labour to govern by conviction nor honour its manifesto promises. As The Times headlined in July: "Britain has elected the most godless parliament in its history", with half the cabinet, including the prime minister, electing to swear allegiance to the King without the Bible. Ominous if predictable.

Here are some key issues with manifesto promises that we must be aware of and watch over.

Here are some key issues with manifesto promises that we must be aware of and watch over.

LABOUR MANIFESTO 2024		
Life and health		
Abortion	No mention but Labour has championed abortion for any reason up to birth. Will this be a free, conscience vote since it is not a manifesto issue?	
'Assisted Dying'	No mention in manifesto but Starmer pledged that parliament will debate and vote on changing assisted dying laws if Labour won the election. Will this also be a free, conscience vote?	
Covid/Pandemics	Will appoint a fixed-term Covid Corruption Commissioner to recoup public money lost in pandemic-related fraud and from contracts which have not delivered. Labour will respond to the findings of the Covid-19 Inquiry. States that the Covid-19 pandemic showed "how a strong mission-driven industrial strategy, involving government partnering with industry and academia, could turn the tide on a pandemic". Since this is the approach the Government will employ for any subsequent pandemics, we need clarity if it refers just to vaccines or to the whole pandemic experience.	
Identity		
'Conversion Therapy'	A draft Conversion Practices Bill will introduce new restrictions on "abusive" practices intended to change people's sexual orientation or gender identity.	
Gender Dysphoria	Will implement recommendations from the Cass Review but make crimes against LGBT+ people an aggravating factor in law.	
Safety		
Law enforcement	Crack down on antisocial behaviour with more neighbourhood police. Tough new penalties for offenders, yet post-election it announced plans to release unspecified prisoners once 40 per cent of their sentence is served.	
Border security/ Immigration	Promises to reduce net migration. Will set up a new Border Security Command to "smash criminal boat gangs", end asylum hotels, and fast-track removals to safe countries for people who "do not have the right to stay here".	
Family		
Marriage	No mention of traditional marriage or family but Labour has shown clear support for same-sex marriage. The whole emphasis for family is economic but no mention of supporting mums at home through the tax system.	
Education	Will levy VAT on private school fees to fund 6,500 more state school teachers. Will ensure schools address 'misogyny' and teach young people about healthy relationships and consent.	
Foreign policy/Religion		
Israel/Palestinian Territories	Committed to recognising a Palestinian state. Emphasis on Gaza ceasefire before release of hostages. Advocates two-state solution.	
Islam	Will introduce a Race Equality Act to include an all-party parliamentary group to determine a definition of 'islamophobia', ie as a form of racism	

Sir Keir Starmer, speaking at the World Economic Forum, the place he prefers to Westminster, in January 2023, said that in order to meet "our obligations in relation to the climate crisis... we need to go towards Net Zero." He added: "We ... have set a stretch target of 2030 for clean power generation."

This is seen as a clear reference to UN Agenda 2030, seen by some as fulfilling Bible prophecy by ushering in global governance in the name of preserving the planet.

PRIME MINISTER



KEIR STARMER Failed to prosecute GPs doing gender abortions

Formerly Director of Public Prosecutions, he controversially failed to prosecute doctors accused of agreeing to terminate a pregnancy on the grounds of gender, saying it was not in the public interest to do so.

Starmer's overall voting record is consistent with progressive positioning in-cluding so-called virtue signalling with his 'taking the knee' in 2020 (the symbol of Black Lives Matter), and his ongoing struggle with defining a woman because of the newly-assigned meaning of the word 'gender', ie that it is fluid.

He is a staunch 'remainer' and advocate for a second Brexit referendum, and confirmed his globalist outlook when he expressed his preference for Davos (ie the World Economic Forum) over Westminster (when interviewed by Emily Maitlis).

He did not oppose the Government over its Covid response apart from saying its measures such as lockdown should have happened sooner and that he would want to silence anti-vax voices.

Starmer continues to vacillate hopelessly between two irreconcilable demands: to uproot the historical antisemitism in his party while pandering to the growing pro-Palestine Islamic factions that, in some towns across the country, comprise ten per cent of the population.

In November he said: "Hamas's stated aim is to wipe Israel off the map. They committed the most brutal attack on Jews since the holocaust and now they are using innocent Palestinians as human shields. I would like to register my shock that not every Member of this House can say this truth: Hamas are terrorists.

By April 2024 Lammy expressed "serious concerns about a breach in international humanitarian law" over Israel's response, saying "far too many people have died". He also said to Sky News: "My judgement is if we get a ceasefire, more hostages will be released. That's the first thing, and more aid will get into Gaza to alleviate the famine that's now taken over'

Then in May, after the ICC prosecutor requested arrest warrants against Netanyahu and Gallant (Defence Minister), Lammy said he would comply with such warrants and has done so in his first week in office, overturning the objection raised by Sunak's government that had restrained the ICC.



■ Voted in favour of abortion for any reason up to birth (13 March 2017), of making DIY abortions permanent, and for cen-sorship ('buffer') zones outside abortion clinics, outlawing prayer and consensual communication between the public and women seeking abortion.

Genuinely conflicted on assisted dying having voted in favour of the 2015 bill. Suggested citizens' assemblies could propose new laws on such tricky issues but no mention of assemblies in manifesto. His growing reticence to push for law change appears to have taken an about-turn under the influence of Esther Rantzen, the new assisted dying champion.

Voted consistently in favour of all Covid restrictions imposed so need to watch his stance on any subsequent 'pandemics' will he be another Matt Hancock?

HOME SECRETARY



Curiously, she has voted against a stricter asylum system and stronger laws and enforcement of immigration rules, rather contradicting manifesto promises! She has also consistently voted against making it easier to remove someone's British citizenship which has implications for the Islamist presence already here.

Another concern is surveillance; she has voted in favour of mass surveillance and retention of information about people's communications and activities.

So there appears to be an inconsistency between Cooper's own positioning and the Government's official position with respect to our borders and internally, as well as a failure to acknowledge or tackle the already clear and present dangers among the Islamist groupings.

■ As a former (very pro-EU) MEP with an Oxford constituency, her roots are undeniably 'progressive'. She has said that the definition of a woman depends on the context; ie she differentiates between biological and legal definitions (only one of which is, of course, mutable).

Voted consistently for gay rights including same-sex marriage and for race equality, so watch out for Labour's manifesto promise to introduce a Race Equality Act covering equal pay, protections and "other racial inequalities"

Women's rights campaigners, Sex Matters, fear her equalities (rather than scientific) approach to 'conversion therapy' will be harmful.

She supports transgender people being able to declare their own gender.



After a meteoric rise to power in just ten years, beginning as a trade union representative, Rayner identifies as "soft left" and, with a modest academic record, famously speaks in the vernacular attracting significant support from Labour's voter base

She is hard-line on law and order and has reportedly said "Shoot your terrorists and ask questions second." As a member of Labour Friends of Palestine and the Middle East she has generally sided against Israel, but has stopped short of calling for a clear ceasefire in Gaza and of accusing Israel of genocide, infuriating Muslims here

In May she courted the Muslim vote promising to recognise Palestine as a state – a likely reaction to losing the Rochdale seat to de facto Muslim George Galloway in a by-election.

But appeasement measures proved inadequate as five independent candidates won traditional Labour seats in July on clear pro-Palestine tickets, endorsed by pressure group The Muslim Vote, that emerged last December in response to the Gaza war.

EDUCATION SECRETARY



BRIDGET PHILLIPSON Progressive idealist who may back parents' rights

■ She appears to be the author of imposing VAT on private schools to fund 6,500 more state school teachers, and of a big childcare reform, starting with free breakfasts in all primary schools. This may seem a noble motivation but we must keep a watch on this, given the continual progressive move to undermine parental authority and traditional family order, and her consistent voting in favour of same-sex marriage and gay rights.

No commitment yet to keeping the new sex education guidance for schools that bans the teaching of gender ideology and limits sex education to nine-year-olds and above

She maintains that "families come in different shapes and sizes" but also that parents must see what their children are being taught, and be involved in their education.

CHANCELLOR OF THE EXCHEQUER



Ambitious churchgoer facing taxing issues

■ Her voting on tax issues is mixed; she is against raising the threshold at which people have to pay income tax, but in favour of raising the tax rate on income over £150,000. Not a great champion of socalled 'working people', then.

Her focus is economic growth for which she believes that the role and contribution of women in the workforce is vital. As a former Bank of England economist, she sought to demonstrate to other women that there should be no limits to their ambition, which has led to her being the first woman to occupy No 11.

This sets off familiar warning bells about undermining the traditional family, so it is unlikely she will be proposing tax breaks for married couples anytime soon.

SHABANA MAHMOOD Devout Muslim who votes for abortion and gay rights

Mahmoud is one of the first female Muslim MPs who is open about her devotion to Islam: "My faith is the centre point of my life and it drives me to public service, it drives me in the way that I live my life and I see my life." However, her voting pattern is typically Labour, even on the sensitive

However, her voting pattern is typically Labour, even on the sensitive issues of abortion and gay rights which are entirely at odds with her religion.

Her constituency comprises 41 per cent adult Muslims, so the backlash against her following Starmer's faltering position on the Gaza war has been severe. She has taken part in pro-Palestine marches.

She says her priority as Justice Secretary is both relieving our overcrowded prisons and building new ones.

MILIBAND'S 'ECONOMIC SUICIDE'

New green measures "threaten national and food security"

Ed Miliband, the former Labour leader who lost the 2015 election, declared war on fossil fuels in his first week in office by saying that no new licences would be issued for future oil and gas drilling in the North Sea, as well as cancelling plans for a new coalmine in Cumbria, although that was mired in controversy.

According to energy journalist Michael Young, cancelling drilling licences is "economic and technical suicide".

Young says: "Our dash to reach Net Zero by 2050 is playing into the hands of China, which is showing increasing belligerence on the world stage, since many of the rare metals needed for the electric motors and batteries are sourced from that country."

"It's also extremely dangerous to rely on the intermittent production of electricity from wind and solar sources. Such a policy is groundless idealism



fighting against reality. Sooner or later all the economic and technical realities will have to be faced by the Net Zero fanatics."

FEARS FOR FOOD SECURITY AS MILIBAND PUSHES THROUGH BRITAIN'S BIGGEST SOLAR FARM


Energy Secretary Ed Miliband has been accused of endangering the nation's food security after bulldozing through objections to give the goahead for Britain's biggest solar farm on green land.

It's not just those who have stood firmly across all pro-life issues; even some of the less full-throttled support from the likes of Victoria Prentis and Maria Caulfield has gone.

All this is good news for the 'prochoice' activists. Heidi Stewart, CEO of The British Pregnancy Advisory Service (BPAS), told The Independent that this parliament could be the most proabortion in history.

She said: "The last parliament saw unprecedented attacks on our abortion rights, no doubt emboldened by the global attack on abortion. The antiabortion lobby was well-resourced, well-funded, and well-connected. And through several anti-abortion MPs, they were able to pose a significant threat to the provision of abortion."

Ms Stewart has also expressed a wish that the incoming Labour government will "urgently progress the implementation of safe access zones, Things are looking dire for unborn babies after 15 pro-life Tory MPs lost their seats. And with abortion already at unprecedented levels in Britain, a pro-abortion leader has hailed the new parliament as the most pro-abortion in history. However, hope remains after independent, prolife candidates stood for election

and decriminalise abortion for women in England and Wales."

This does not make for comforting reading. The Criminal Justice Bill, which could allow for abortion up to birth, was due for a vote in June but the snap general election meant it was cancelled. Now Labour MPs Stella Creasy and Diana Johnson, who had proposed amendments to the Bill that would decriminalise abortion, potentially right up until birth, are back in parliament, whereas Sir Liam Fox and Caroline Ansell, who had tabled amendments to lower the abortion limits for both

Down's Syndrome and healthy babies, are no longer in parliament.

Yet there is some light in this otherwise dark tunnel and certainly much we can pray for. Ten pro-life MPs have retained their positions and this issue does not always split along party lines. Labour's Mary Glindon, Carla Lockhart of the DUP and Liberal Democrat Tim Farron are among them.

Around the world, an estimated 73 million babies lose their lives to abortion every year. In the UK, we have aborted more than ten million babies since the Abortion Act was passed in 1967.

The largest number ever recorded across the UK was in 2022, when we surpassed a quarter of a million abortions at 267,974, a 17% rise over the previous year. That meant over 700 babies per day lost their lives to abortion in 2022 alone.

THE CANDIDATES WHO SPOKE UP FOR BABIES

This election saw, for the first time, 22 independent candidates stand solely for unborn babies and their mothers. The Vote Life campaign saw leaflets delivered to more than one million homes.

Each Vote Life champion raised the £500 candidate's fee, plus around £800 towards the government's costs in printing leaflets that Royal Mail delivered to every home in their prospective constituency. The leaflets featured a picture of a living, developing baby in the womb at six weeks following

FRENCH CHIEF RABBI TELLS JEWS TO LEAVE

France's chief rabbi warned French Jews to leave France after a far-left pro-Islamist party won a parliamentary majority.

President Macron's deci-sion to call a snap election has backfired – resulting in more far right and far left MPs being elected, and strengthening the hand of a far left leader who has failed to condemn Hamas. In the first round of voting

in the general election on 30 June, the right wing party Na-tional Rally (RN) topped the polls. RN's leader, Marine Le Pen, has managed to dis-tance herself from her notorious late father, Jean-Marie Le Pen, who described the Nazi death camps as a 'detail". His daughter has supported Isra-el and enjoyed the support of rural French people who are appalled at the strong Islamist presence in cities.

Macron plotted to keep RN out of power by cutting a deal between his own centrist party, Renaissance, and far left groups, which involved 200 centrist and left-wing candidates being dropped in specific regions, concentrating the leftwing/centrist vote into one op-

tion for voters. The plot worked, but instead of Macron's party coming out on top, the far-left pro-Islamist New Popular Front (NPF) secured the most parliamentary seats, knocking Renaissance into second place and RN into third - even though RN secured more votes than either of the other groups.

As a result, no party has an outright majority, and a power struggle began, with the prospect of some of the NPF's extreme policies being accepted



French rioters started fires and attacked police with fireworks

in order to form a government. Allister Heath, writing in the Daily Telegraph (20 June), described the NPF as "a miserable alliance of the extreme Left, socialists, communists, greens and assorted misfits' and warned that given the chance it would "introduce gender self-ID, liberalise immigration, slap an embargo on arms sales to Israel and back the scandalous international court cases against the Jewish state. Their manifesto is not just dementedly woke and Israelophobic but would bank-rupt France."

Candidates for citizenship will find two new questions in their application exam which refer to "Germany's special historical responsibility for the National Socialist unjust regime and its consequences, especially for the protection of Jewish life."

One of the new questions prospective asks citizens: "Which action relating to the State of Israel is forbidden in Germany?"

The correct answer is "Publicly calling for the destruction of Israel.'

PAPUA NEW GUINEA

OVER 300,000 BAPTISED

CHRISTIANITY IS UNDER ATTACK IN THE UK

New report shows Christians being forced into silence

A shocking new report from Voice for Justice UK reveals a disturbing trend: Christianity is under attack in the UK.

Christians are being coerced into endorsing ideologies they oppose, forced into silence, and stripped of their freedom of conscience.

The survey, which gathered responses from 1,562 individuals, paints a grim picture of a society increasingly hostile towards Christians.

An overwhelming 92% of respondents affirmed traditional marriage between a man and a woman, opposed abortion, and disapproved of premarital sexual relations.

Alarmingly, a fifth experienced harassment, bullying, or discrimination, impacting their careers. More than half faced outright hostility and ridicule.

The biggest challenges came from the LGBT movement. With compelled speech and compulsory lanyards, they could be forced to participate in an ideology they disagreed with. Christians were forced to self-censor or lose their jobs on account of their faith.

While no protected characteristic should be more important than another, for Christians their faith came at the bottom of the list.

Schools are the lynchpin in the normalisation of LGBT ideology. Legally required to have respect for the parent's religious and philosophical convictions, schools taught progressive ideology instead. If children did express Christian beliefs, they could be bullied by pupils and intimidated by teachers.

Worst of all, Christian teachers were put in a very difficult position where they were required to teach materials which against their faith. One teacher told us: "I know personally of four teachers wo have either lost their job or had to leave it. In each case it is because they cannot think as required."

Éven churches themselves were becoming secularised as they adopted progressive ideologies. Disillusioned, the largest group of Christians (30 per cent) had left the denominations and now described themselves as 'Christian, no denomination'.

Lynda Rose, the Director of Voice for Justice UK explained: "Christianity lies at the foundation of British society, underpinning our tolerance and acceptance of diversity. But our survey shows Christians in the UK, both in the workplace and socially, are increasingly subjected to discrimination and marginalisation. Society has fallen victim to an ideology actively hostile to Christianity. This is a contravention of our law. If we want to safeguard our tolerance and freedom, then we need to protect Christianity itself.

Synod vote sparks split

A few days after Sir Keir Starmer announced outside Downing Street that Britain needed a 'reset', the C of E sealed its own reset by voting to continue standalone services for same-sex blessings.

The Church of England Evangelical Council (CEEC) has expressed its "deep disappointment" at the General Synod's vote to continue the process towards introducing standalone services of blessing for same-sex couples.

The 9 July vote also saw the Church of England move closer to removing current restrictions on clergy being in same-sex marriages, with proposals to be brought to General Synod in February 2025.

Entire blessing services for same-sex couples were approved

As a result, the Church of England's Evangelical Council (CEEC) has commissioned Honorary Assistant Bishops and other clergy to provide "informal oversight" to ministers who do not wish to be led by a bishop who voted for same-sex blessings. A group of 20 overseers were appointed in a service at a leading evangelical Anglican church – All Souls Langham Place in London.

C of E steps ever closer to gay marriage

After the Synod agreed In November 2023 to offer blessings for same-sex couples within services, trials of entire services of blessing for same-sex couples were approved at the 2024 General Synod – albeit by a very close vote.

Not only that, but a timetable to work towards clergy same-sex marriages was endorsed. Following all these decisions, many clergy and parochial church councils (PCCs) expressed their need for alternative oversight.

The original approval of same-sex blessings was given on the understanding that they did not "seek to simulate marriage", yet standalone services are now a step closer to wedding services.

DRAG 'HUMILIATING' TO WOMEN AND A DANGER TO KIDS

Women have described drag as "a grotesque caricature of femininity" in response to a Guardian article celebrating RuPaul's TV show.

They wrote in after after LGBT activist Max Wallis praised RuPaul's Drag Race UK vs The World as "a much-needed cultural phenomenon" that "helped to destigmatise" the LGBT community.

ISRAEL'S WAR IS <u>OUR</u> WAR

As Israel stands on the frontlines against a resurgence of antisemitic fervour, echoes of the past remind us of a universal struggle for freedom and faith. In a world still shadowed by the spirit of Nazism, Christians and nations with Judeo-Christian roots must recognise the common fight for survival

aving celebrated the 80th anniversary of D-Day – a military invasion that saved the free world – we have been reminded how the Jewish state is currently performing a similar task on our behalf.

The Nazi spirit is still alive, not only in the Middle East but also on the streets of major Western cities. Yet where are Israel's allies?

All those countries built on Judeo-Christian foundations should be right behind them. But they are mostly in appeasement mode once again.

Isn't it time we realised that Israel's war is OUR war? Christians, especially, are directly affected and should take this opportunity to stand up and be counted.

But as the war itself continues to make media headlines, the focus of Christian attention has retreated to spiritual navel-gazing, remaining largely silent in the face of the most serious antisemitism since the 1930s.

In fact, it's worse than that era, according to Bournemouth pastor Werner Oder, the son of a Nazi war criminal. He says that in pre-war days it was at least contained within the European sphere, whereas now it has spread across the globe. Dietrich Bonhoeffer and too few

Dietrich Bonhoeffer and too few other Christians stood up to Hitler and paid with their lives. Some may yet be called to die for their Jewish brothers. Also risking their lives for Jesus – and their Jewish friends – are a growing body of Iranian believers who have discovered that love for their supposed enemies is a direct consequence of their faith in Jesus. In fact, it was on the streets of Tel

In fact, it was on the streets of Tel Aviv, where terrified Israelis had only weeks earlier come under a hail of rockets from Iran, that a young Iranian man brought a message of love, hope and reconciliation.

Unashamed and unabashed, Rami¹ declared how his life had changed

through the Jewish Messiah and prayed that Israel and Iran would once again be friends.

Speaking amidst two and a half hours of worship in a city square organised by the Dutch-led Presence revival movement (now accessible on YouTube), he said: "I was taught to hate the Jews and to hate Israel. Every morning in school they told us to say 'death to Israel; death to America'." Rami explained: "I was 19 when a Jewish rabbi changed my life. God turned an enemy into a friend. Now, in Iran, millions are coming to know Yeshua. He's the perfect Passover Lamb, the Yom Kippur sacrifice. Isaiah 53 tells us that he took our sins and bore our sicknesses. He took our place.

"I was a lost Muslim man full of hate and bitterness. I was a Gentile, and Yeshua changed my life. Millions of people in Iran now love Israel because of Yeshua."

Referring to the regime which has repeatedly vowed to destroy Israel, so recently demonstrated by its launching hundreds of missiles at the Jewish state in April, Rami assured the gathering crowd: "The Islamic regime does not represent the people of Iran. They have taken a nation hostage. I pray that Iran and Israel become friends again."

"Millions of people in Iran now love Israel because of Yeshua"

He said Israel had given hope to the world through the Bible and prayed that Israelis would recognise that Yeshua is their Messiah.

Here is the answer to an age-old conflict: right in the midst of war, Israelis are hearing about the amazing peace that their 'enemy' has found through Jesus!

This is the reconciliation between Jew and Gentile referred to by the Apostle Paul when he said: "For he himself (Christ) is our peace, who has made the two groups one and has destroyed the barrier, the dividing wall of hostility... his purpose was to create in himself one new man out of the two, this making peace, and in one body to reconcile both of them to God through the Cross, by which he put to death their hostility" (Ephesians 2:14-16).

Christians should know that the global warmongering we are witnessing today is a sign that Jesus will soon return. And we are reminded that, whereas the Gospel began with the Jewish people, it will also finish with them.

Sapir was put on a motorcycle and taken to Gaza: "At the beginning of my captivity, I kept asking God why he had to bring me to that place. Soon enough, it became clear. I was being held with hostages who were doing much worse emotionally and I made it my mission to bring them hope."

DEATH CHANT

A black Muslim Israeli citizen named Tamar, a recent university graduate, has boldly declared: "I am the living embodiment of Israel not being an apartheid state.

Sapir is urging Jewish communities in Israel and outside to be united, after one of her captors taunted her that they would strike again when the Jews' post-7 October unity dwindled.





in other conflicts including Syria and Afghanistan – plus tens of thousands it can call on from across Lebanon in any future open conflict with Israel. Turkey has also been moving armaments to Syria and fighters have been coming from Afghanistan and Pakistan.

It will be a conflict that makes the current devastating fighting in Gaza look like an afternoon picnic

The Israeli government must weigh up the consequences of an all-out attack on Hezbollah. Will opening up a second front in the north draw Iran into open warfare with Israel?

Will it mean the Houthis in Yemen increasing their attacks on Israel's southern flank? Will it draw in Islamists in Svria and Iraq?

What will Russia and China do? What will Turkey do? Will the Christian, Druze and Sunni populations of Lebanon really come together and risk another civil war to remove Hezbollah from destroying the country?

Will the current US administration offer tangible support to Israel in what will be a conflict that makes the current devastating fighting in Gaza look like an afternoon picnic? These questions, and many more, the Prime Minister and his government must wrestle with every day.

But maybe the ultimate question is: what is the God of Israel doing in all of this...what are his intentions?

US IS HEZBOLLAH'S

After it was revealed that Iran funded the "grassroots" pro-Hamas demonstrations on college campuses across the US over the past nine months, a senior Hezbollah official clarified their real aims on television, which has been translated from Arabic courtesy of media watchdog MEMRI (Middle East Media Research Institute): "This war is not with Israel; Israel is merely a tool. The primary battle, the real war, is with America".



The Secretary-General of Hezbollah, Hassan Nasrallah, gave a speech on 17 July in which he declared that Hez-bollah would continue to fight Israel, especially since a dearth of IDF tanks had been reported, due to the nine months of war in Gaza.

He threatened to destroy any tanks that entered Lebanon and to target new Israeli civilian areas, that he termed 'settlements', although the land is legally Israel's.

WHAT IS HEZBOLLAHP

Hezbollah is a Shi'ite Islamist political party and paramilitary organisation that was founded in 1982 to fight the Israeli invasion of Lebanon.

Israel had invaded Lebanon in response to attacks from the Palestinian Liberation Organisation (PLO), which had based itself in southern Lebanon. Israel was mostly successful in dealing with the PLO, but in the process, Hezbollah rose to prominence as the main terrorist resistance movement for Lebanon's Shi'ite community.

Hezbollah is credited with being one of the first Islamic terrorist groups in the Middle East to use tactical suicide bombings. Its infamous Tyre truck bombings, its bombing of the USA embassy in Beirut in early 1983, and the 1983 Beirut barracks bombing – which killed over 300 French soldiers and USA marines – were models adopted by other terror groups for their own purposes.

It was supposed to have disarmed and disbanded

This type of attack continued against Israel and the South Lebanon Army throughout the 1980s and 1990s, until Israel withdrew from Lebanon in May 2000. This was ten years after the end of the 16-year Lebanese Civil War, after which Hezbollah – along with all the other factions involved in the fighting – was supposed to have disarmed and disbanded.

Initially, under Syrian patronage, but followed long-term by Iran, Hezbollah was allowed to

IRAN PLANNED A MULTI-FRONT WAR AGAINST ISRAEL

Hamas's terror invasion was only one element within a multi-front attack planned by Tehran, according to leaked remarks by Israeli PM Netanyahu.

"We discovered during the IDF operation in Gaza that [Hamas leader Yahya] Sinwar simply opened fire too early — that Iran is planning to put us in a stranglehold of its proxies — to invade us, from Gaza, Lebanon, Judea and Samaria, Jordan," he said.

Netanyahu made the remarks when meeting with the bereaved families of female observation soldiers massacred at the Nahal Oz base nine months ago. maintain its arsenal, and control the Shia areas in southern Lebanon along the border with Israel. The part the terrorist organisation played in Israel's withdrawal from Gaza in 2000 gained it a great deal of respect within Lebanon, as well as in the wider Arab and Islamic world.

UNIFIL and the Lebanese Army failed abysmally to enforce Resolution 1701

At the end of the 2006 war with Lebanon, UN Resolution 1701 was passed requiring Israeli forces to withdraw from the country, and all combatants on the Lebanese side of the border to disarm and withdraw to a demarcation line north of the Litani River (approximately 18 miles from the border with Israel). A UN-sponsored monitoring force (UNIFIL) was created to then supposedly keep the peace in the demilitarised corridor.

Israel did withdraw, but UNIFIL and the Lebanese Army (LAF) failed abysmally to enforce Resolution 1701. Meanwhile Hezbollah gradually took over the day-to-day running of Lebanon as a shadow government that is actually more effective in running most aspects of the economic basket case that is today's Lebanon.



MUCH-DELAYED movie about former US President Ronald Reagan finally hits American cinemas on 30 August, not long before this year's Presidential election.

Hollywood actor Dennis Quaid takes the lead in 'Reagan'. Described by The Guardian as one of the best actors never to have been Oscar-nominated, Quaid has starred in hits like 'Innerspace' (1987), 'The Parent Trap' (1998) and 'The Day After Tomorrow' (2004).

After beating his cocaine addiction, the actor returned to his own childhood faith around 1990 and in recent years he has lent his acting talents to faithbased films like 'Soul Surfer' (2011) and 'I Can Only Imagine' (2018). Quaid told The Chicago Sun-Times: "I grew up in a Southern Baptist church, became disillusioned with it as a teenager. I turned to Eastern religions and philosophies... read the Koran, went to India nine times. Along the way, I came back to Christianity... We're all spiritual beings whether we know it or not."


In another interview he explained more: "I went around the world, actually, in my late 20s, and the question I had was, 'Who is God?'... So I came back, and I read the Bible cover to cover. For me, it's Jesus... How simple it is."

When The Christian Post asked Quaid what heaven will be like, he



Elisha has survived 38 years of drug abuse which led her to places of hopelessness and desperation until she had an encounter with Jesus in 2013. Here she tells her story

> I was a broken, lost little girl in an adult's body.

I'd grown up on the outskirts of London

as a middle child with an older and younger brother, and never felt I really belonged.

I always felt that my dad favoured my older brother and that my mum preferred her youngest, so as a kid, growing up, I started to seek negative attention to get noticed and was very naughty.

My memories of life at home are also of my mum having mediums and clairvoyants around the family home and I visited a clairvoyant.

I also began to steal; around age nine I was thrown out of the Brownies for nicking Brown Owl's purse!

nicking Brown Owl's purse! By the age of 11 I was also angry and start drinking and smoking. I was excited to start secondary school and looking forward to a different environment with new friends. I liked learning, too.

But once in secondary school, I started gravitating towards people who were rebellious. I started mixing with the girls who were getting into trouble and before I knew it I was expelled at 13 for stealing from teachers.

Around age nine I was thrown out of the Brownies for nicking Brown Owl's purse!

and I'd listen to my name mentioned during readings. It was spooky and I'd be scared to go to sleep without the light on.

From a young age, though, this sparked a curiosity about the supernatural and witchcraft fascinated me. Even in primary school, a friend My friends and I took it in turns to wait till the teacher went to the other end of the classroom, then keep watch while one of us 'dipped' the teacher's bag.

Sent to a remedial school, I was thrown in with lots of other rebellious kids and my behaviour escalated. I

was chaotic; I couldn't stop lying and stealing and was expelled within a year.

No school would accept me after that and I was put in an assessment centre, then sometimes sent back home, but I always ran away from home and stayed with friends. The police always brought me back.

I embarked on a completely lawless lifestyle – burgling houses and nicking cars.

Istarted dabbling in drugs-I'd sniffed

glue at school, and this progressed to amphetamines and sleeping tablets.

By 18 I'd had my first child and been evicted from my first flat in Penge, London. I continued on my downward journey, ending up in Holloway, where I spent my 21st birthday.

Coming out of prison, I longed to be able to change; I was full of selfhatred, with no self-worth, hopeless and desperate, but I couldn't break the cycles of destructive behaviour.

A lot more happened which would fill

a book; I was a petty thief to pay for my drugs and there were times I've eaten out of bins and planned to rob takeaway drivers. At home there was no gas or electricity and I lived in squalor.

There were several overdoses - one was deliberate, the rest accidental - and once I was dead on arrival at hospital. I was a walking dead person; I looked dead and was spiritually dead. I had no hope, no direction and didn't know who I was.

At times I'd be in the police station or in court and I'd be crying out to God, praying. I remember being on my hands and knees in a police cell, imploring God, "I won't do this again if I can get out of here.

I had no hope, no direction and didn't know who I was

My last spell in prison was in 1997 for drug and driving offences.

Meanwhile I'd also had two more children who were being looked after by my family.

In April 2000 I had my fourth child. a little girl, but social services issued an ultimatum that if I didn't go into rehab and successfully complete it, my daughter would go to the adoptive family that they had already set up.

So I came down to a rehab in Hove to try to get clean, hoping to become a good mother and keep my child.

That was not to be.

Within two weeks of rehab, I relapsed and had to sign a declaration that if I used drugs again, my daughter would be adopted. Even knowing I'd lose my baby, I was powerless to resist the drugs

I ended up losing her, which broke my heart - and was thrown out of the rehab.

I stayed in the Brighton and Hove area, continually wanting to get clean but never succeeding, despite being in and out of 12-step fellowships like AA (Alcoholics Anonymous) and NA (Narcotics Anonymous)

Finally, in 2013, my life dramatically changed. I'd been in an unhappy, dependent relationship with a drug dealer for two years. When I finally managed to leave, I really was at the end of myself. I was taking so many drugs - heroin, crack cocaine, plus lots of tablets and was drinking alcohol, too.

After a long wait, I got a place in a specialist hospital unit and had the most horrendous detox. I was in awful pain, but knew I had to get through it.

Towards the end of the rehab, a friend suggested doing the Alpha course that was about to start at St Peter's Church, Brighton. Although I was now off drugs, I couldn't see how I'd cope; I'd never worked legally or had my own place. I knew that if God didn't step in, I wouldn't make it.

During the course, I had lots of questions about Jesus. A lady in the group advised me to take a Bible home and read the Gospels.

Once home, I couldn't put the Bible down - I was so hungry for the truth. Through reading the Gospel of Mark and how Jesus healed people, raising



them from the dead and casting out demons, light bulbs went off in my head.

Everything started to fall into place I could see the source of the demonic stuff I'd wrestled with all my life. The Scripture that sealed the deal was how Jesus went to the Cross and overcame the power of Satan by the work he accomplished at Calvary.

This was confirmed in a powerful encounter when I was walking to a meeting one day. I heard an audible voice telling me over and over again, "You know the truth now". I knew this was Jesus and surrendered my life to

I was going to church regularly and was supported practically and in prayer by the vicar's wife, Sam Coates. After leaving rehab, I went to live with Sam and her husband Archie

In church, I used to think, "I don't want to be a Sunday Christian, I want to know Jesus personally.

Another friend at church had booked for us to go on holiday to Portugal together. Beforehand, she told me about Ellel Ministries which was putting on courses and these caught my attention. I ended up cancelling the holiday and putting myself on a ten-day course at Ellel called 'Micronets'.

It was probably the best thing I'd ever done. My spirit was 'fed' by the wonderful teaching there on forgiveness and getting to the roots of problems, and I felt the Holy Spirit nudge me to do their year-long course of discipleship and prayer ministry.

I had no money to pay the fees, but stepped out in faith and went for the course interview.

On my 50th birthday I was accepted on to the course. One of the leaders interviewing me said, "We'd love to have you on the course - and by the way, an anonymous donor has paid half your tuition fees!'

So I left the Coates' home for Ellel Ministries in Surrey, where I spent year of learning and receiving intensive prayer. The prayer ministers were led to pray into the roots of some of the issues that had kept me bound for years, which were chiefly occult practices, addiction, rejection and unforgiveness. I received incredible freedom and went from knowing about the Lord to knowing him personally his goodness, grace, mercy, protection and provision

Since then I feel I've been raised back

to life. I'm not the same person; I know who I am now, and, more importantly, WHOSE I am. I've never had a desire to stick a needle in my arm or drink again. I don't battle cycles of destructive

behaviour or wake up wanting to die. After the course ended, I started working for Ellel Ministries on reception and after a year was asked to be the PA to the previous director, Jill Southern. I worked for Jill for three years, travelling round the world with her on her teaching ministry.

In 2018 I felt called back to Brighton to work for St Peter's. My role was to help set up a night shelter which ran for three years until lockdown in 2020. It was mind-blowing to find myself helping others, rather than as someone in need of help!

It's a miracle I'm still alive, serving God

God has turned my life around and given me purpose and brought extensive healing and deliverance. With my past, people have asked me for years if I'd ever considered prison ministry. It wasn't something I wanted to do, until a couple of years ago when I visited a young man in prison. When I saw the other prisoners looking so hopeless, I felt God breaking my heart, just as his was breaking for these guys. Soon after, I was invited to a young offenders institution to help with the baptisms of young men who had just surrendered their lives to Jesus on the Alpha course.

After the baptisms I met the chaplain, which led to me being able to go into the prison to support the young lads in their faith.

Being with these guys in the prisons and seeing them growing in their faith brings me a lot of joy and I wouldn't want to be anywhere else.

To say God has turned my life around is an understatement. It's a miracle I'm still alive, serving him.

Throughout my life I'd been in relationships, but since 2012 I haven't felt the need for any relationship except with God. I try to stay close to Jesus; I read my Bible daily, pray and surrender afresh to him so I can stay on the "narrow path", where I know the Lord's strength and protection.

Every day I thank God for Jesus' shed blood which has redeemed me from the years of darkness that I existed in.

Nick chose the dirt road. He told God that he wanted more in life, "but not with material things... My soul is crying out for something bigger." So, towards the end of Season 3's

So, towards the end of Season 3's filming, he accompanied some guys from the set to a church conference. He had never seen such genuine love for Christ before. He was simultaneously impressed and "weirded out".

FIRMINO'S BURNING LONGING

Ex-Liverpool striker turns pastor

ROBERTO Firmino, who won the Champions League and Premier League with Liverpool, has swapped the pitch for a pulpit.

The Brazil and Liverpool striker was consecrated at his church in Brazil this summer, according to Premier Christian News. Firmino founded the church with his wife Larissa Pereira.

"Jesus is love. Just believe it"

Announcing the news on social media, they wrote: "Since our encounter with Christ, a longing burns in our hearts... Let people know this love that has reached us. Now we have another craving and responsibility... to be pastors after God's heart, who cooperate with the Kingdom of God."

Former teammate Alisson Becker, Liverpool's goalkeeper, baptised Firmino in a swimming pool in 2020. Firmino said at the time: "Jesus is

love. [There is] no explanation. Just believe it. Just believe and feel the Holy Spirit."

Firmino still holds the record as the highest-scoring Brazilian in Premier League history, with 82 goals.


What is Cultural Marxism?

The OED defines it as: "Used depreciatively, chiefly among rightwing commentators: a political agenda advocating radical social reform, said to be promoted within Western cultural institutions by liberal or leftwing ideologues intent on eroding traditional social values and imposing a dogmatic form of progressivism on society. Later also more generally: a perceived left-wing bias in social or cultural institutions, characterised as doctrinaire and pernicious."(2) The birth of Cultural Marxism took

The birth of Cultural Marxism took place in Frankfurt, Germany, in 1923 within the Institute of Social Research, known later as the Frankfurt School. This, it turned out, became the centre of a conspiracy to bring down Western democracies.

CLOAKED IN CULTURAL MARXISM

THE MARXIST TARGETING OF JUDEO-CHRISTIAN BELIEF AT WORK IN OUR SOCIETY



In the 1930s the School's director, Max Horkheimer, concluded that Western culture's Judeo-Christian heritage was the major obstacle to the spread of Marxism. So he developed 'Critical Theory' (3) to bring the "current society and culture down through unremitting,

destructive criticism."

The aim is to destroy the Judeo-Christian foundations of society, and it has been very effective. See how this has affected the whole tone of how we approach things:

i) Individualism and individuality

are downplayed

(ii) Rational debate is out of the window

In the early 20th century, Edward Bernays (the "father of public relations") had used insights from his uncle, Sigmund Freud, to manipulate people's unconscious desires so they bought advertisers' products; shopping was no longer simply a matter of need, but of wish fulfilment.

Consumerism, as we now know it, took off, and materialism followed. In turn, Bernays' ideas were adopted into politics through Critical Theory and the work of the Frankfurt School.

Due to the imminent outbreak of World War 2, the leaders of the Frankfurt School relocated to the USA, and in particular Columbia University (the centre of antisemitic student protests in May 2024) from where by the 1950s Cultural Marxism became mainstream.

The growth in influence of Cultural Marxism in the UK

The BBC rejects Christian morality

Let us see if we can simplify what is going on. Steve Maltz calls it "an insidious philosophy" which the following will show. I have another name for it (courtesy of the film of the same name): 'Pulp Fiction'.

In the UK we have seen the development and rise of Cultural Marxism particularly since the end of World War 2. We also see it in the development and acceptance of Critical Theory and 'Crisis Theory'. Marxist cultural theory unmasks contemporary culture, and notably mass culture, as a system of social domination of the individual (4).

Broadly, Marxist critique of specifically British culture assumed increasing prominence from 1956, through the Centre for Contemporary Cultural Studies in Birmingham (hence the common references to a 'Birmingham School' of cultural critique) led by Raymond Williams. The British tradition of Marxism, especially over the past 50 to 60 years, has been influenced by theorists.(5)



have been subverted. These include 'The New Left', 'victim culture', sexual liberty and licentiousness, anarchism, extreme left-wing liberal thinkers, 'gay rights – LGBTQ', 'cancel culture', CND and 'peace' movements, religious intolerance and the destruction of Judeo-Christian heritage, support of Islam, antisemitism and deconstruction of the family and of 'family values'.

These biases manifest themselves in every aspect of our society, Government and civil service, local government, education, the NHS and banking.

The BBC is perhaps the best example of progressive Cultural Marxism in the UK. Its management is made up of liberal progressives.

We can see this demonstrated most weeks in BBC current affairs programmes, news bulletins and sport. The BBC is enthusiastic for anything that breaks accepted norms, which it calls 'stereotyping'

The BBC distorts the news to promote a liberal agenda, says Robert Aitken in his book 'The Noble Liar'. In the same book he exposes how the BBC rejects Christian morality, but supports Islam by staying silent about serious wrongs emanating from Muslim communities.

The late Sir Roger Scruton said: "Intellectuals are naturally attracted by the idea of a planned society in the belief that they would be in charge of it". The BBC has been accused of dominating the media by its elitism and the marginalisation of dissidents. It has views on everything and beware if you disagree!

A religious challenge

The challenge to Israel and the Christian Church is centred upon the person and works of God, his choice of Israel as his covenant people, salvation, truth, moral and ethical righteousness and judgement among many other things. The attack is insidious and uses many or all of the tactics shown in the

diagram in this piece. For example, the United Methodist Church in the US has recently lost over one million members due to LGBTQ ideology and the ordination of gay clergy. There is a direct clash between gay ideology and evangelical classical theology as the former is not part of the faith and cannot lead to salvation.

A geo-political challenge

Democracy is under threat as elections and manifesto commitments give way to rule by the mob and the demands of whoever can shout loudest or demonstrate most forcefully. And since elites (politicians, civil service, diplomats, judges, academics, journalists and the rest) cast themselves in the mould of Plato's philosopher kings, they believe they are better qualified to decide what should happen than their supposed inferiors.

Cultural Marxism is a huge challenge to the populations of the US and Western nations, although not to their governments, because they have been taken over by this ideology. We are seeing how insidious and evil this is, particularly in the US's Biden administration's dealings with Israel.

Cultural Marxism is just another expression and outworking of the antichrist agenda for world domination and the eradication of Israel and Christians

In addition, we can see how Cultural Marxism has taken over the UN, the ICJ (International Court of Justice) and the ICC (International Criminal Court), leading them into constant censuring of Israel and threatened legal action against the Jewish state through lies, propaganda and bribery.

Conclusion

Cultural Marxism is just another expression and outworking of the antichrist agenda for world domination and the eradication of Israel and Christians. Only God can and will stop it and show to the world that Israel's God is the one true God.

IRAN ARMENIAN CHRISTIAN GIVEN **TEN-YEAR PRISON SENTENCE**

rmenian Hakop Gochymayan has been sentenced to ten years behind bars for participating in Christian activities. This comes after he lost an appeal against the harsh

sentence in June. International Christian Concern (ICC) reports there was "no clear evidence" against Gochymayan. The judge made his decision on assumptions rather than proof.

They were in Iran to visit family

Gochymayan and his wife, Elisa Shahvardian, who is of Iranian descent, were arrested in August 2023. Elisa was released in October but Gochymavan remains incarcerated.

In addition, Barnabas Aid reports that the couple have had to endure solitary confinement and were "subjected to intense psychological torture"

The couple, who had their two young children with them, were in Iran to visit friends and family but reportedly Gochymayan had some copies of the New

Testament in Farsi, and had visited different churches in Iran.

It is illegal in Iran to evangelise and to have Bibles in Farsi (the official Iranian language) but the underground Church continues to grow.

EVANGELIST KILLED AFTER LEADING MUSLIMS TO CHRIST

church evangelist who received death threats from Muslim extremists has been murdered in eastern Uganda.

Richard Malinga's body was found on 17 June at Kayete Swamp in Akisim A village, Butebo District. Just before dying he texted his pastor that he was surrounded by Muslims. His pastor (name withheld for security reasons) replied several times but received no answer. Local residents who found Malinga's body also found his phone and called his pastor, who then called the police.

They found him in a pool of blood...tied with ropes

One resident told Morning Star News that they had heard a "loud wailing", rushed to the scene and "found the victim in a pool of blood...

tied with ropes."

Malinga's pastor said that the evangelist had been visiting homes in the area bringing the Gospel and several people had become Christians, including some radical Muslims.

ERITREA MOTHER AND CHILDREN FORCED TO CONVERT TO ISLAM

Christian mother, Elvin Joseph, and her three daughters must become Muslims due to Iraq's Personal Status Law, reports International Christian Concern.

"I am married to a Christian man with three Christian kids"

This law states that children must adopt Islam if one of their parents converts to Islam. As Elvin's mother has turned Muslim after marrying a Muslim, Elvin and her daughters must follow suit.

Elvin protests: "I am married to a Christian man. I have three Christian kids... All my official documents are Christian. Our marriage is registered by the church."

ersecution of Christians has worsened in Eritrea with 218 arbitrary arrests in 12 months, including children.


This means around 400 Christians are now in prison for their faith, with no prospect of a trial. UK-based Release

International (RI) says: "Most were taken from their houses – some at 3am... some children have been arrested with their parents, and in some cases the whole family is in prison.

"We are very concerned for the physical and mental wellbeing of the children, some of whom are only two years old. This is totally unacceptable, and we strongly condemn this inhuman act by the Eritrean government."

In 2002, the regime headed by Isaias Afwerki outlawed most Christian churches and began arresting Christians. Some have been incarcerated for over 20 years, some were held in steel shipping containers in the hot desert, some have been

tortured, and others have died from abuse and untreated illness.

The best known prisoner, who died in May aged 83, was Rev Ghirmay

Araya, one of the founding fathers of the Full Gospel Church in Eritrea. Arrested along with other church leaders in 2021, Rev Ghirmay was never charged with any crime. He suffered from diabetes and related illnesses and was held in the maximum security Wengel Mermera Central Criminal Investigation Centre, along with other church leaders. Some had been detained for 20 years. Release International says: "Rev Ghirmay endured his suffering with steadfast faith " faith.

One of Rev Ghirmay's sons has also been imprisoned for his faith for the past seven years. Sources say he is being kept in a shipping container. Although they were in the same prison, father and son had no opportunity to meet, and the son was not even aware of his father's death.

Release International partner Dr Berhane Asmelash said: "I'm deeply saddened by Rev Ghirmay's death. He served the Church diligently for more than 60 years in both Eritrea and Ethiopia. His ministry extended across the Orthodox, Lutheran and, finally, Full Gospel churches." Dr Asmelash expressed his deepest condolences to Ghirmay's five children and 13 grandchildren.

PAKISTAN WIFE OF MURDERED CHRISTIAN **DIES OF HEARTBREAK**

widow traumatised by the death of her husband at the hands of a Muslim mob has passed away. Allah Rakhi Bibi, 72, cried every day after 74-year-old Nazeer Masih Gill was beaten to death by attackers who falsely accused him of blasphemy.

Her pain worsened when she heard the killers had been granted bail

Christian Daily International reports that the grieving widow died of cardiac arrest on 21 June. Her family say she could not bear the loss of her husband, who was beaten up on 25 May and died on 3 June

Son Sultan Gill said: "Her pain and agony apparently worsened when she overheard some family members talking about the bails being granted to the people involved in my father's killing. We tried our best to keep this information from her, but we failed.

He says they recorded statements of false witnesses to aid the case of Nazeer's killers, while failing to preserve the crime scene. round 70,000 internally dis-placed Christians are facing a humanitarian crisis in Manipur.

According to the Evangelical Times, the Christians fled their homes after militant assaults on their villages earlier this year. Aid agencies say help for the victims has mainly come from churches, with the government providing only about ten per cent of the support.

The Christians' situation has deteriorated after recent flooding, which has destroyed personal belongings and what little food they had, as well as hampering the

The British Asian Christian Association (BACA) has made the crisis its priority appeal due to ongoing violence and predictions that the floods will return.

nearby trees? This could change as a fossilised parrot has been found in Cretaceous rocks, overturning the popular view of the 'Age of dinosaurs'.

Nature commented: "The existence of this fossil supports the hypothesis... that most or all of the major modern bird groups were present in the Cre-taceous." (2)

Fossilised ducks

Forty fossil specimens of a very modern-looking, webfooted, duck-like bird named yumenensis' 'Gansus were discovered in similarly aged rocks in China. BBC News online reported: "Ducks may have been paddling around in primeval swamps when T-Rex was king of the dinosaurs." (3)

'Gansus', which resembled

modern grebes, "could fly like modern birds," said Jerald Harris of Dixie State College in Utah. "In short, no one expected to find a bird this modern in rocks this old." (4)

Finds like these totally undermine the popular theory of bird evolution.

Modern animals found with dinosaurs

Over 13 years, biologist and medical doctor Dr Carl Werner travelled 160,000 miles, visiting ten dinosaur dig sites and 60 natural history museums. After searching the literature, he

began interviewing scientists, and discovered that all the major groups of modern plants and animals had indeed been found as fossils in the same rocks as dinosaurs. His conclusion, based on the facts, is that evolution has not happened. His research is recorded in his book and DVD series, 'Evolution, the Grand Experiment'.

The flood preserved evidence of God's Creation

In the April/May paper we featured an "urgent warning" to Britain which Rev Jennifer Abigail Lawson-Wallace believed she had received from God. Now she has been led to bring a message of hope in the gathering darkness

Despite the current spiritual condition of the UK, I believe that God has every intention of fulfilling his promises to bring revival, restoration and reformation to this land again, but we must rise up! (Luke 1:37)

Even when there appears to be famine, God offers us hope. In Genesis 26, Abraham had died and there was famine in the land.

Then God appeared to his son, Isaac, and affirmed the covenant that he had with his father. God assured Isaac that despite the prevailing situation, he had every intention of fulfilling his promises to Abraham.

The wells had been blocked

"All the wells which his father's servants had dug in the days of Abraham his father, the Philistines had closed and filled with earth". (Genesis 26:15)

Isaac's predicament was that although God had greatly prospered him, his heritage had been taken over by the Philistines. The wells he inherited from his father Abraham had been sabotaged and

blocked by the enemy. This was a serious matter and of great significance and concern because:

- 1. The wells belonged to Abraham and were the fruit of his labour, as his servants had laboured to dig them. Therefore, the wells formed part of Isaac's inheritance.
- 2. The wells produced water, without which there would be no sustenance of life, for the people and their livestock and crops.
- 3. The wells were landmarks of Abraham's journey with God, which the Bible cautions us not to remove. "Remove not the ancient landmark which your fathers have set up." (Proverbs 22:28)
- 4. Finally, the ownership of the wells had been sealed by covenant oath, which had been broken by blocking them. (Genesis 21:22-32)

Isaac restored his heritage

"And Isaac dug again the wells of water which had been dug in the days of Abraham his father, for the Philistines had stopped them after the death of Abraham; and he called them by the names which his father had called them." (Genesis 26:18)

There is a spiritual famine in the land

Isaac did not tamper with or give the wells new names based on his own experiences; he called them by the names given to them by his father. Thus, Isaac restored the full purpose and function of the wells – to sustain life and to act as landmarks for him and his people.

Our current situation in the UK

The fathers of the Christian faith in this nation have long died and gone, and there is a spiritual famine in the land. (Amos 8:11; 1 Samuel 3:1; 2 Chronicles 15:3; Proverbs 29:18)

Worse still, the enemy has stopped, seized and taken over the Christian heritage that the fathers laboured for and left behind for posterity. We have turned our backs on Jesus Christ and his Word and Spirit and embraced alternative ideas and other gods.

Humanist philosophies and political correctness have removed and destroyed the ancient landmarks of biblical truth, holiness and sanctity of marriage and



life. Sadly, a generation has arisen that does not know or honour God. (Judges 2:10)

Despite the current situation, however, God has every intention of fulfilling his promise to Jesus Christ and to the forefathers of this land, and is seeking to restore, raise and use the Church to turn this nation around. (John 10:10)

Re-digging the ancient wells

It is time, therefore, to re-dig and revive the ancient wells of the Christian faith in Britain. We must re-dig the Kingdom wells of God's righteousness, peace and joy in this land again. (Romans 14:17; Isaiah 32:17)

Courage in the face of brutal persecution

Brother, I Have Come to Arrest You

By Dr Berhane Asmelash

have just finished reading the story of a remarkable man, Dr Berhane Asmelash, an Eritrean who endured imprisonment for Christ.

Fiona Bruce, the former Vice Chair of the All-Party Parliamentary Group for International Freedom of Religion or Belief, who, sadly, lost her seat in July's election, writes: "This book needed to be written – and needs to be read. The world should know of the suffering and bravery of thousands of Eritreans, barbarically imprisoned, tortured, and killed – simply on account of their beliefs. And to know that this is happening right now, in the third decade of the 21st century."

Conditions for many prisoners of faith in Eritrea are unbelievable. Many – Dr Berhane believes as many as 2,000 – have been held in shipping containers where they bake in the African sun in the day and freeze by night.

One such prisoner was the Christian Gospel singer, Helen Berhane. Of her experience of a freezing winter's night in an Eritrean shipping container, she wrote:

"A single candle flickers, its flame barely illuminating the darkness. They never burn for more than two hours after the container door is locked: there is not enough oxygen to keep the flame alive.

"Condensation drips from the roof and slides down my cheek, and when it moistens my lips, I taste rust. The air is thick with the ever-present stench of the bucket in the corner, and the smell of close-pressed unwashed bodies.

"I cannot believe this is my life, these four metal walls, all of us corralled like cattle, the pain, the hunger, the fear. All because of my belief in a God who is risen, a God whom I am forbidden (by the authorities) to worship."

Life was hard for Dr Berhane as a boy. Skinny and weak, he was bullied at school and hated himself. When still in his teens, he was diagnosed with diabetes.

In his early 20s, with Eritrea in the midst of civil war, he committed his life to Christ. From then on all he wanted to do was to talk about Christ.

One day, the Communist cadre in the town sent him, and some other Christians, a letter informing them they were to be executed. They were accused of being CIA spies. Copies of the death sentence were posted around the town.



Daniel chapter 3, the story of Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego and the threat of a fiery death that they faced. They read how Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego told the king (Nebuchadnezzar), that they would serve no god but the living God. Despite the Eritrean Communist cadre having a reputation for executing many young people, they stood firm, and saw more and more young people join their Bible study group.

Today Dr Berhane Asmelash has been freed from prison in Eritrea, granted asylum in the UK, is married and runs a ministry called Release Eritrea, which, as the name implies, is seeking to help those still suffering persecution for their faith in Eritrea.

Unstoppable Church -Embracing God's Development Plan

By Hugh Osgood

Nowhere does Hugh explain the title he has given this book, 'Unstoppable Church'. When I first saw it, I assumed it referred to the Church on the march around the globe. But when you read the book, Hugh is clearly talking about individuals – who make up the Church - on a constant, unstoppable development in their own Christian walk.

The Lord has used Hugh in a remarkable way over the years. He has been a successful pastor, and a great influence for good across cities and through missions in different parts of the world. His roles have included the Free Churches President of Churches Together in England and founding President of Churches in Communities International.

What is different about this book is that Hugh takes the reader back to his own beginnings as a Christian, long before all his success in ministry. He uses his personal story - not to brag about his early beginnings – but to

illustrate New Testament principles for discipleship and relationships.

When he became a Christian, he was studying dentistry and immediately wanted to switch to theology, but God's plan was for him to become a dentist and initially work in that field. He wanted to use his work skills overseas on the mission field – but God's plan was for him to be in south London.

Initially as a young Christian he was part of a house group and considered himself an up and coming 'travelling speaker'. One day the leader of the house group asked to see him for a heart-to-heart talk.

Hugh describes the conversation: "Then the list began; all the things I had been getting wrong, described one after another as 'Here's another nail in your coffin'."

Hugh writes: "At the end of the conversation, the house group leader said to me, "Your teaching opportunities are put on hold for three months".

For three months Hugh did nothing, except listen and pray. That one-hour heart-to-heart and the three months after changed his life.

'Unstoppable Church' is a good book for leaders as much as those starting out on the Christian life. It teaches principles for walking with God and being in a right relationship with others in the Church. At the end of the book Hugh writes:

"Jesus has been building his Church through the centuries. We see his handiwork throughout the book of Acts... We see it in history... What of today?

"All the ingredients are there. The resurrection life of Jesus is still the same. Let's make this happen so that today's world can experience the irresistible momentum of God's 'Unstoppable Church'."

A classic biography of the revered Narnia author

C S Lewis – A Life: Eccentric Genius, Reluctant Prophet

am sure (almost) every reader of this review will have read at least one of CS Lewis's books.

He wrote such classics as 'Mere Christianity', 'The Screwtape letters', and the children's classic series, the Narnia chronicles, of which 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe' is probably best known. His books have sold millions of copies and are still popular today.

But how many of us really know the man who wrote the books, Clive Staples Lewis, or CS Lewis as he is usually known?

I came across Alister McGrath's biography on CS Lewis while browsing in a charity shop. It was first published in 2013 and is still available from good bookshops and online stores, as well as charity shops!

Before McGrath started to write CS Lewis's story, he read every single book CS Lewis ever wrote. He also read all Lewis's preserved letters, which are 3,000 pages long!

Finally, McGrath read all the other

biographies about CS Lewis, which took 18 months. Only then did he start to write. Thus this is the most thorough biography possible and, I suspect, the most accurate of the many biographies on CS Lewis.

Born in Belfast on 29 November 1898 to a solicitor and a clergyman's daughter, Lewis was brought up to attend church and say his prayers. All that changed when his mother died of cancer in 1908.

His father didn't cope well with her death and arranged for Clive and his brother to go to boarding school in England. The school had an abusive headmaster, whose harsh regime Lewis described as a "concentration camp".

described as a "concentration camp". Aspects of CS Lewis's early life make for uncomfortable reading. The events of this time convinced Lewis that there was no God and he declared himself an atheist.

As school finished, he passed the entrance exams to Oxford, but World War 1 broke out and he ended up in the trenches in France. In April 1918 he was wounded and brought to hospital, so while recuperating he passed the time by reading, including books by Christians such as GK Chesterton.

Gradually, despite himself, he was drawn in. Lewis would say of this time that

later Lewis published 'A Grief Observed' under a pseudonym. He had drawn on notebooks he kept after his wife's death that revealed his immense grief and a period of questioning God.



Alister McGrath devotes entire chapters to describing how and why Lewis wrote some of his best known books. The idea for 'The Screwtape Letters' came to CS Lewis during a dull sermon at his local Oxford church – Holy Trinity, Headington Quarry.

The idea was born for a senior devil, called Screwtape, to give advice to a junior devil, called Wormwood, on how to be a good tempter.

Lewis described it in a letter to a friend: "Before the service was over... I was struck by an idea for a book which I think might be both useful and entertaining. It would be called 'As one Devil to Another' and would consist of letters from an elderly retired devil to a young devil who has just started work on his first 'patient'."

Lewis's imaginary 31 'Screwtape Letters' became a sensational bestseller. His reputation as a skilled and popular Christian theologian and writer was confirmed and remains to this day.



Now Everything Changes

By Steve Maltz

When a Palestinian flag is discovered flying on top of a remote hill in England's beautiful Lake District, something is surely amiss.

And it proves the trigger for one man's search for truth in a world that has seemingly gone mad.

This new book by prolific author Steve Maltz – his 35th – is perhaps his most important yet. He challenges us all, in a most engaging way, to face up to the realities and consequences of the 7 October massacre in Israel.

It's short and sharp, but not so sweet. For it may offend. The author uses fictional characters Derek and Dawn Courtney, who have little knowledge of the Middle East conflict and certainly no axe to grind, to wake up a sleepy world (and church) to the monster of antisemitism that has stalked the globe for so long and which no-one seems to understand.

Too many have bought into this lie

Steve uses the well-known story of the Christian doctor who was asked by King Frederick the Great of Prussia for irrefutable proof of God's existence. "The Jews, your Majesty!" was the doctor's reply. No other nation has been hated so much and yet survived millennia of pogroms and attempted genocide while mighty empires have come and gone.

He deals well with the land, and why it legitimately belongs to the Jews, and to the controversial issue of Palestinian refugees, used as political pawns to justify continued vilification of Israel as a supposed uncaring oppressor instead of being absorbed by their neighbours as Israel has done for Jews expelled from Arab lands. And he outlines how 'Two-state solutions' have already been offered on several occasions but rejected by Arabs each time.

The bald truth is that the likes of Hamas have absolutely no intention of peaceful co-existence with the Jews. Their clearly stated goal is to exterminate them. And yet, in our upside-down world, it is Israel, not Hamas, that is accused of genocide.

Too many have bought into this lie which, in the end, has them siding, not just against Israel, but against God himself. It is this aspect that greatly concerns the author, a Messianic Jew (ie follower of Jesus), since much of the Christian Church (at least in the UK) is either ambivalent on the subject or downright antisemitic in practice.

Tragically, the Church has a long history of antisemitism, especially as perpetrators of much Jewish persecution during the Middle Ages. Even the great reformer Martin Luther stained the Gospel message in this way. As the author concludes: "The fence is

HEALTH WATCH A win for medical freedom

Christian barrister Paul Diamond has successfully defended a mother who was fighting against her disabled son being forcibly vaccinated with the controversial Covid MRNA injection.

He was able to prove that the constituents of the jab would have done more harm than good for the young man's condition.

Previously in this paper (Dec/Jan 2021-22) we reported on Diamond's successful efforts to protect school-age children from receiving the Covid jab; the letter he sent to school authorities was also available to readers.

This victory comes as tweets about bird flu intensify, with the disease known to have spread to cattle. The US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) confirmed in April 2024 what is believed to be the first mammal-tohuman transmission of the virus after a person came into contact with presumed infected dairy cows in Texas.



Meanwhile German firm Wacker has inaugurated a brand new MRNA production facility in Halle, which will have the capacity to manufacture up to 200 million doses of MRNA vaccines per year. Christian Voice queries the purpose of this when there have been calls for MRNA injections to be banned after multiple reports of adverse effects, including from Britain's health watchdog, the MHRA and oncologist Prof Angus Dalgleish (HEART June/July).
